Gearing up for Safety

Black River Falls, Mel-Min High School Agricultural teachers and UW-Madison Division of Extension are offering the Gearing up for Safety tractor and farm equipment safety training course June 20, 21, 22 at the Black River Falls agriculture classroom. Training starts at 8 am each day. Training is located at 1200 Pierce St, Black River Falls, WI 54615. There is a \$25 fee for the course.

Youth aged 12 and up are encouraged to attend this course. Youth will receive classroom instruction and hands-on driving instruction and practice. Upon successful completion, youth will be able to operate a tractor on their guardian's farm at age 12 and a non-related person's farm at age 14.

Daily instruction will go from 8 am to 4 pm each day. Students must bring their own lunch. There will be snacks and water provided by the educators. The hours are required to meet the specifications of the Department of Labor certification.
