



## Youth Tractor & Machinery Safety Program

The Wisconsin Youth Tractor & Machinery Safety Certification Program is designed to meet requirements established by the US Department of Labor, pertaining to special provisions made for the employment of youth ages 14-15 on farms not operated by their parents. In addition, Wisconsin Act 455 provides specific provisions for tractor operation by 12–13-year-olds.

UW-Madison Division of Extension provides Wisconsin's course instructors with current, research-based curriculum content, creates partnerships and solutions to ensure access to courses statewide, and administers the course participant certification. Extension also facilitates a website where organizations can list their courses and families can find courses in their region. 
